Details & Attractions

We will provide a safe event for families on Halloween night, focused on kids ages 10 and under. This will be October 31, from 5:30 to 8 pm, at Albion Elementary School parking lot.

Attractions include:

- Trunks - ideally we would like to see 15-20 trunks - instructions will be given
- Bandstand featuring the live music by the Blue Mountain Boys
- Café with coffee, hot apple cider, and goodies for the grown ups
- Craft station
- Bouncy castles
- Helium balloons (a perennial favourite!)
- Games
- Kids will receive candy, Focus on the Family CDs and other fun trinkets as well as invitations to youth group & children's programs, and other events at Cornerstone
