

Sermon on the Mount: True Disciples

Matthew 7:15-23



Here's what happens...

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus warns about false prophets—people who seem trustworthy but aren't. Jesus says to determine who truly loves him by the fruit you see in their lives.

Someone with a bad heart can't produce good fruit, and someone with a good heart can't produce bad fruit.

Bible Point:

Jesus' friends live like him.

¹⁶ By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? ¹⁷ Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. (*Matthew 7:16-17*).
