

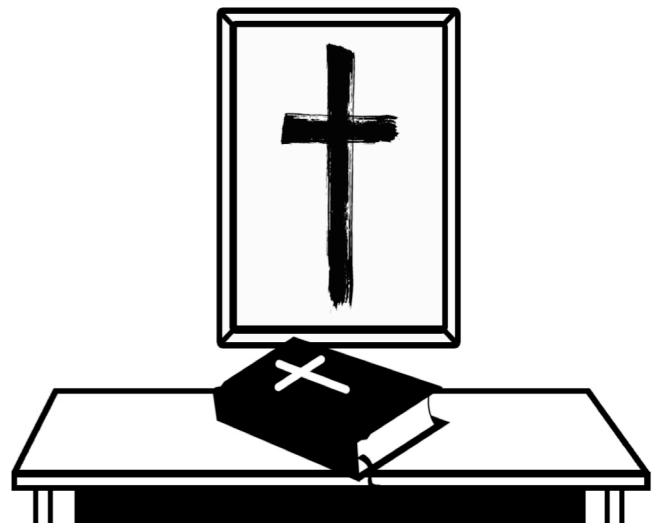


The disciples tell Thomas they saw Jesus—alive—after he'd died! Thomas doesn't believe them. He says he needs to see and feel Jesus' wounds. Jesus appears, and Thomas believes. Even though we can't see Jesus, we can trust that Jesus is real.

Family Together Time

- If someone came to your house looking for evidence you believe Jesus is real, what would they find? Go on a hunt to find evidence of what you believe.
- You can also find things that can remind you that Jesus is real—even if they're not meant to be about Jesus. Here are some examples.
 - A fan: You can feel its wind but you can't see it. You can feel Jesus even though you can't see him.
 - A mirror: Jesus lives in you! The way you live can show Jesus to others.
 - A closet light: The bulb lights up a dark closet. Jesus lights up the darkness in our lives.
 - Soap: Jesus washes away our sins.
